BE A GOOD NEIGHBOR

We are asking everyone to be aware of the rules and guidelines of the community. They are published on the back page of the community directory. As a reminder, be aware that

swimming and boating are at your own personal liability and that parents are responsible for their children. This is especially important in the use of golf carts. Children and teens as well as adults need to be cautious of speed and stopping/slowing at intersections.

Fire pits are allowed; however, please be aware of the size of the fire and the wind. We often have wind conditions that can be dangerous and fire pits should not be used. No other fires are permitted.

Noise at night and in early morning can disturb neighbors. Please keep music at a reasonable level and be aware that voices carry, especially at night.

The open space and beach areas are in an environmental protected zone. No motor vehicles including ATV type vehicles are allowed. Exceptions are designated parking areas and maintenance vehicles.

Dogs are to be kept on leashes and we ask that owners clean up after their dogs.

ELECTIONS OF OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS

Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Directors for East, West and Central Districts, and two At Large Directors.
